

Application Guidelines for the Global Hope Scholarship Program for Fall 2026

The Office of Global Affairs is pleased to announce the **Global Hope Scholarship Program for Fall 2026**. Please see details of the scholarship below and apply within the designated period.

1. Global Hope Scholarship

This scholarship is provided by the Samsung Dream Scholarship Foundation to foster outstanding undergraduate and graduate students from developing countries with the potential to become future global leaders.

2. Eligible Applicants ([must meet all the below requirements](#))

★ Important Notice on Nationality:

In accordance with the Foundation's annual quota guidelines, applicants with Mongolian nationality are NOT eligible for this round.

• Academic status (Applicants must fall under one of the following categories):

- Undergraduate students newly admitted to Seoul National University for Fall 2026
- Currently enrolled undergraduate students at SNU
- Graduate students newly admitted to SNU for Fall 2026 (Master's, Doctoral, or Combined)
- Currently enrolled graduate students (Master's, Doctoral, or Combined Master's & Doctorate)

• Nationality: Must hold citizenship from a country listed on the **DAC List of ODA Recipients** (*see attached list*)

• [The following applicants are not eligible](#)

- Applicants who have completed one or more semesters of elementary, middle, or high school education in Korea
- Recipients of the Global Korea Scholarship (GKS)
- Applicants of Korean ethnicity, even if they hold citizenship from a DAC List country

• Tuition Waiver Restriction (Undergraduate only): Undergraduate scholarship recipients must **not** receive any other scholarship that provides a **tuition waiver** during the scholarship period

• Language Requirement: Must hold a valid **TOPIK score of level 2 or above**

3. Candidate(s) to be selected: SNU will recommend up to four candidates (up to twice the

expected number of final scholarship recipients).

These recommended candidates will be forwarded to the Samsung Dream Scholarship Foundation after the internal document screening by the Office of Global Affairs (OGA).

(Depending on the circumstances, the foundation may choose to NOT select any candidate.)

4. Scholarship Benefits

► Undergraduate

- Full tuition waiver
- Monthly stipend (KRW 800,000 each month)

► Graduate

- Scholarship of up to KRW 4,800,000 per semester (amount may vary depending on other scholarships received)

5. Scholarship Period (within the standard duration of the degree program)

- Bachelor's degree program: maximum 8 semesters
- Master's degree program: maximum 4 semesters
- Doctoral degree program: maximum 6 semesters
- Combined Master's & Doctorate program: maximum 8 semesters

6. Required Documents

- Please refer to the Application Checklist (Page 1 of the application form). All documents may be submitted in either Korean or English.

7. Deadline:

- Submission to OGA by an electronic official document from the applicant's college by July 10th, 2026 (Friday)

1) Submit required documents to your designated college's administration office **(see list below for details)**

2) Please contact the administration office of your designated college regarding submission deadlines to your college's administration office.

*** Important:** Early submissions are strongly recommended so that the college's administration office can prepare to submit your documents by an official document to the OGA.

8. Final Selection & Interview

- Document screening will be conducted by the SNU Office of Global Affairs.
- Recommended candidates will be interviewed by the Samsung Dream Scholarship Foundation.
- **Interview Period: August 2026 (in-person)**
- **Final Result Announcement: To be announced by the Foundation (via email from the**

Foundation)

- (Only successful candidates will be notified.)

9. Scholarship Continuity Assessment: At the end of each semester, the Foundation will review each scholarship recipient's academic performance and enrollment status to determine eligibility for continued scholarship support. All scholarship recipients must meet the following requirements:

► Undergraduate scholarship recipients:

Must maintain a GPA of at least **2.7/4.3 while completing at least 15 credits per semester**, AND must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 3 after completing 2 scholarship semesters, must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 4 after completing 4 scholarship semesters, must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 5 after completing 6 scholarship semesters.

► Graduate scholarship recipients:

Must maintain a GPA of at least **3.0/4.3 while completing at least 6 credits per semester**, AND must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 3 after completing 2 scholarship semesters, must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 4 after completing 4 scholarship semesters, must be a holder of a TOPIK score of level 5 after completing 6 scholarship semesters.

※ Recipients who fail to meet the required TOPIK level on two or more occasions will become ineligible for continued scholarship support for the following semester.

10. Leave of Absence

Scholarship recipients who wish to take a leave of absence must consult with the Office of Global Affairs in advance and obtain approval from their college in accordance with the University's academic regulations.
